### Course Entry Requirements

Million Brown's College has the following entry requirements. International students must:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Have completed a minimum senior high school qualification equivalent to Australian Year 12.
- Have an IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent, with no band less than 5.0. Test results must be no more than 2 years old where applicable.

English language competence may also be demonstrated through documented evidence of any of the following:

- Completion of at least 6 months of a Certificate IV or higher qualification through full-time study in Australia.
- Completion of a Certificate III or higher qualification through full-time study in Australia.
- Completion of ELICOS Upper-Intermediate level.
- Other English language evidence assessed by MBC in accordance with its Admission and Enrolment Policy.

Other English language tests, such as PTE and TOEFL, may be accepted. Students are required to provide their results so MBC can confirm equivalency to IELTS 6.0.

Qualification-specific entry requirement: Entry to BSB60420 Advanced Diploma of Leadership and Management is limited to students who have completed a Diploma or Advanced Diploma from the BSB Training Package (current or superseded equivalent versions) or have two years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience in an operational or leadership role in an enterprise.

### Course Structure

The BSB60420 Advanced Diploma of Leadership and Management qualification is made up of 10 units of competency from the BSB Business Services Training Package. These consist of 5 core units and 5 elective units, as outlined below.
